

Based on the decision of the Council of the Faculty of Physics, University of Rijeka, the Faculty of Physics, University of Rijeka, Radmile Matejčić 2, announces this

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

for the selection of **one (1) associate to an associate position of assistant (m/f)** for a fixed-term employment contract, full-time, in the field of Natural Sciences, area of Physics at the Faculty of Physics, University of Rijeka.

Candidates must meet the requirements prescribed by the Higher Education and Scientific Activity Act (OG 119/2022).

The following documents must be submitted with the application:

- CV (Curriculum Vitae),
- a copy of proof of citizenship of the Republic of Croatia or another country,
- a copy of the diploma of completion of the appropriate university graduate or integrated study in the scientific field of Natural Sciences, Physics,
- a transcript of grades or a supplementary document on studies,
- a certificate of average grades during studies,
- motivation letter, highlighting the applicant's motivation for the position and any qualifications for preferential treatment based on the conditions listed below.

Conditions for preferential treatment in the selection process:

- teaching experience,
- scientific or professional training during or after studies,
- prior knowledge and practice in scientific research work in the field of experimental physics and/or materials physics,
- work experience with experimental techniques: SEM, ALD, XPS, UV-vis, Raman,
- well-developed interpersonal skills, success in working as a member of a collegial team.

Both men and women may apply under the same conditions. Terms that have gender significance are used neutrally and refer equally to both males and females.

Candidates whose native language is not Croatian must also submit proof of knowledge of the Croatian language, level (B2) according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Candidates who completed their studies outside the Republic of Croatia must submit a decision/opinion on the recognition of a foreign higher education qualification or proof of initiating the procedure for acquiring the same.

Candidates who, based on special regulations – The Croatian Homeland War Veterans and Their Families Act (Official Gazette 121/17, 98/19, 84/21 and 156/23), Article 48 of the Civilian Victims of the Homeland War Act (Official Gazette 84/21), Article 48f of the Act on the Protection of Military and Civilian War Invalids (Official Gazette 33/92, 57/92, 77/92, 27/93, 58/93, 02/94, 76/94, 108/95, 108/96, 82/01, 103/03, 148/13 and 98/19), Article 9 of the Act on Professional Rehabilitation and Employment of Persons with Disabilities (Official Gazette 157/13, 152/14., 39/18. and 32/20.), invoke the right to priority in employment, are obliged to refer to this right in their application and to enclose all evidence required by special regulations for the exercise of this right. Candidates who refer to this preferential treatment will only be given preference under equal conditions.

Candidates who refer to the right to employment priority under The Croatian Homeland War Veterans and Members of Their Families (Official Gazette 121/17, 98/19, 84/21, 156/23) are required to submit

all necessary documentation established in Article 103 of the Act, along with their application according to the list at the link:

Candidates who refer to the right to priority in employment according to Article 48 of the Act on Civilian Victims of the Homeland War (Official Gazette 84/21) are required to submit all necessary documentation established in Article 49 of the Act in question, along with their application for the call, according to the list at the link: <https://branitelji.gov.hr/UserDocImages/dokumenti/Nikola/popis dokaza za ostvarivanje prava prednosti pri zapo%C5%A1l javanju- Zakon o civilnim stradalnicima iz DR.pdf>. Candidates who refer to the right to priority in employment according to Article 9 of the Act on Professional Rehabilitation and Employment of Persons with Disabilities (Official Gazette 157/13, 152/14, 39/18 and 32/20) are required to invoke this right in their application for the call and submit all evidence of meeting the required conditions, as well as proof of disability. Proof of disability is considered to be public disability documents on the basis of which a person can be entered into the register of employed persons with disabilities maintained by the Croatian Pension Insurance Institute <https://mrosp.gov.hr/najcesca-pitanja-i-odgovori-7348/zakon-o-profesionalnoj-rehabilitaciji-izaposljavanju-osoba-s-invaliditetom-7475/pod-kojim-uvjetima-osobe-s-invaliditetom-ostvarujuprednost-pri-zaposljavanju-7477/7477>.

By applying for the call, candidates expressly agree that the Faculty of Physics, University of Rijeka as the manager of the personal data collection, may collect, use and further process data for the purpose of the selection process in accordance with applicable legal regulations.

The deadline for submitting applications with supporting documents is **30 days** from the date of the call announcement in the Official Gazette.

Applications with supporting documents should be sent in scanned form and submitted exclusively via e-mail to the address: fizika@phy.uniri.hr.

The Faculty reserves the right to conduct candidate testing, of which candidates who have submitted timely and complete applications that meet all formal requirements of the call will be notified subsequently. Candidates who do not respond to the interview before the committee and/or testing, lose their candidate status and the opportunity to participate further in the qualification procedure. The Faculty reserves the right to cancel the call and not select any candidate, without any specific explanation.

Incomplete, untimely, and applications that do not meet the formal requirements of the call will not be considered.

The notice of the outcome of the call will be published upon completion of the call procedure on the University of Rijeka, Faculty of Physics's website.
